Articles of Alliance of the International Alliance for Invitational Education

Articles of Alliance

Article I. Name

Section 1.01 The name of this Alliance is the: "International Alliance for Invitational

Education.

Section 1.02 In the Articles of Alliance, the Bylaws, and in public relations, the word

"Alliance" or the acronym "IAIE" may be used in lieu of "International

Alliance for Invitational Education."

Article II. Statement of Principles

Section 2.01 The Alliance holds as its fundamental precepts the following ideals.

- (a) A democratic society is ethically committed to seeing all people as *able*, *valuable*, and *responsible*,
- (b) to valuing cooperation and collaboration,
- (c) to viewing process as product in the making,
- (d) and to developing untapped possibilities in all worthwhile areas of human endeavor.

Article III. Purpose of the Alliance

Section 3.01 Mission Statement

(a) Because the Alliance is dedicated to democratic principles, its mission is to enhance lifelong learning, promote positive change in organizations, cultivate the personal and professional growth and satisfaction of educators and allied professionals, and enrich the lives of human beings personally and professionally.

Article IV. Duration of the Alliancé

Section 4.01 The duration of the Alliance shall be perpetual

Article V. Alliance Headquarters

Section 5.01

The location of the Alliance headquarters will be Kennesaw State University, Kennesaw, GA, USA

Article VI. Leadership

Section 6.01 Board of Trustees (referred here after as the Board)

- (a) The leadership of the Alliance shall be vested in a Board of Trustees, consisting of six (6) elected members, and include two additional permanent positions held by Drs. Purkey and Siegel. Board Members are elected by the Advisory Council for a two-year term, and may serve more than one term. A Chair of the Board will be elected by a simple majority vote of the Board.
- (b) Board member terms will be staggered one year apart in groups of three.
- (c) Board members will elected annually by simple written majority vote of the Advisory Council.

Section 6.02 Advisory Council (referred here after as the Council)

- (a) Further leadership in the Alliance shall be vested in the Advisory Council. The Council will consist of no more than 50 Alliance members and are elected by a simple majority vote of the Board. Council members will serve a two-year tern and may be re-appointed by the Board. The Chair of the Council will be the Executive Director of the Alliance as indicated in section 10.01.
- (b) Alliance staff members will be automatic council members with full voting powers.

Article VII. Membership

Section 7.01 Membership Status

- (a) Individuals may attain Regular Member status in the Alliance upon completion of a membership application and payment of the annual Alliance dues.
- (b) The Board may create additional levels of membership status upon approval by the Council.

Article VIII. Dues

Section 8.01

Annual dues will be reviewed and approved bi-annually by the Board as determined and recommended by the Council.

Article IX. Meetings

Section 9.01

Bi-annual World Conference

(a) A bi-annual World Conference on Invitational Education will take place at a location recommended by the Council and approved by the Board.

Section 9.02

Bi-annual Leadership Institute

(a) A bi-annual Leadership Institute will take place at a location recommended by the Council and approved by the Board.

Section 9.03 Board Meetings

- (a) Meetings of the Board will take place twice yearly as called by the Chair of the Board. One of these meetings will take place at the Bi-annual meeting of the Alliance.
- (b) Non-voting attendees may include the executive director and staff of the Alliance.

Section 9.04 Advisory Council Meetings

(a) Meetings of the Council will take place at the Bi-annual meeting of the Alliance.

Article X. Authority of the Board

Section 10.01 Executive Director of the Alliance

(a) The Board will hire an Executive Director (or the equivalent) to provide leadership in an administrative capacity. Length of service and financial arrangements will be determined by a simple majority vote of the Board.

Article XI. AMENDMENT

Section 11.01 Proposals for amending this document may originate from not less than 10% of the Alliance membership. The membership will present the amendment in writing to the council not less than 120 days prior to the next meeting of the Council.

Section 11.02 Notification and discussion of proposed amendments:

(a) The Chair of the Council will distribute an announcement and copy of the proposed amendment not less than 60 days prior to the next meeting of the Council.

Section 11.03 Ratification of the proposed amendment.

- (a) The Council Chair shall conduct a written ballot of the council members present at the meeting indicated in Section 11.02
- (b) The amendment will be approved for recommendation to the board upon two thirds vote of the council.
- (c) The Council will forward the approved amendment to the Board for adoption its next meeting.
- (d) The board will adopt the amendment by simple majority within 60 days of receipt of the amendment

Article XII. ENACTMENT

Section 12.01 This document is presented as a proposal to the Board for consideration and adoption.

Section 12.02 Adoption of this document requires a simple majority action of the Board.

Article XIII. BYLAWS

- Section 13.01 The day to day duties, responsibilities, functions, policies and operational procedures of all positions and organizational entities named herein will be specified in the Bylaws of the Alliance. (referred here after as the *Bylaws*)
- Section 13.02 The Bylaws will be reviewed bi-annually by the Council and submitted in writing to the Board for approval.

[1] 名稱

本會定名爲《國際啓發潛能教育聯盟(香港)》。

[2]信念

- 2.1 我們認爲所有人皆是有能力、有價值和負責任的;
- 2.2 我們重視合作/協作;
- 2.3 我們視過程本身爲達致成果的重要部份;及
- 2.4 我們應致力發展人的正面潛能。

〔3〕目的

3.1 使命宣言

本會的使命在於鼓勵終生學習,促進教育工作者與有關人士的個人及專業成長和滿足感,推動改善組織/機構的質素,從個人及專業層面豐富人的生命。

- 3.2 宗旨
 - 3.2.1 推廣「啓發潛能教育」,提昇香港教育素質。
 - 3.2.2 促進本地與外地教育工作者或機構之聯繫。

〔4〕組織與功能

- 4.1 本會是一個非牟利團體。
- 4.2 週年會員大會

執行委員會須於每年召開週年會員大會,通過會務報告、財政報告、選舉及商討其他事宜。周年大會以全體會員五份之一或三十人爲法定人 數。

4.3 特別會員大會

會員大會休會期間,倘有緊急事故,而執行委員會認爲需要由會員大會 商議/通過之事項,可召開特別會員大會處理。

4.4 執行委員會

- 4.4.1 由最少五名執行委員組成,職位包括:會長(1名)、副會長(1名)、 財政(1名)、秘書(1名)及委員(1名或以上)。
- 4.4.2 本會各執行委員,均屬義務性質,經由會員大會選出,任期爲兩 年,連選得連任。
- 4.4.3 當以上職位出現空缺時,由執行委員會委任遞補。

[5] 會員

5.1 會員資格

- 5.1.1 名譽顧問:由執行委員邀請本地或外地教育工作者出任爲本會名 譽顧問。
- 5.1.2 學校會員:本港教育機構均可申請成爲本會學校會員。
- 5.1.3 個人會員:現職本港之教育工作者或認同「啓發潛能教育」理念 的人士均可申請成爲本會個人會員。

5.2 會員的義務和權利

學校會員及個人會員必須繳交會費,遵守會章,並在會員大會中享有投票權、選舉權及被選權。

[6] 財政

本會可開設銀行帳戶,所有票據須由會長、副會長及司庫三人中之其中兩人簽署方可生效。

[7]解散

本會須經週年會員大會或特別會員大會議決,並得超過出席會議四分三之 會員贊同,方可解散。

〔8〕修章

本會會章如有任何修訂,均須經週年會員大會或特別會員大會通過,並得社團註冊處批准,方能生效。
