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# 2015 Paula Helen Stanley Fidelity Award Overview

Schools that have received the Inviting School Award are encouraged to continue their study and implementation of Invitational Education through the *Paula H. Stanley Fidelity*\*Award\* program. This reflective process acknowledges schools for continuing to grow and sustain Invitational practices with five levels of Fidelity awards, which may be applied for every two years. The prestigious Gold Starfish Fidelity Award may be achieved after ten years of fidelity commitment to invitational principles.

The Fidelity Award was named for Dr. Paula Helen Stanley, late professor of Counselor Education at Radford University, who served for many years as Director of the Radford University Center for Invitational Education. Her legacy as an inspiring, inviting educator lives on through those who receive the Fidelity Award.

To receive *The Paula Helen Stanley Fidelity Award* schools must complete the following 5 steps:

- 1. Be officially recognized as an Inviting School
- 2. Maintain a current IAIE Institutional Membership
- 3. Complete and submit an application to the Fidelity Award Committee stating interest in applying for the Fidelity Award. **Applications must be received by March 31, 2015.**
- 4. Administer the Inviting School Survey (ISS-R) to at least 100 school stakeholders
- 5. Submit a report including the following components:
  - An assessment of school growth based on the IE Helix model.
  - A summary of how IE has impacted your school climate and culture, and
  - A description of how IE will influence your school's future goals and plans.

All of the required materials must be submitted by May 31, 2015.

#### Requirements to Apply for the 2015 Fidelity Award

#### ALL REQUIRED MATERIALS ARE TO BE SUBMITTED BY MAY 31, 2015

### **Application to Apply for the Award:**

Complete the Fidelity Award Application Form, indicating the next award that your school is eligible for. The school must also hold a current Institutional Membership in IAIE at the time of the application. If your school's IAIE membership is not current, please complete your membership application for 2015 through IAIE or IAIE HK.

#### **ISS-R Survey:**

Purchase and complete the ISS-R survey. The ISS-R survey should be distributed to parents, students, community leaders, staff and administrators. At least 100 surveys should be submitted. #### **Fidelity Award Summary:**

Please submit a summary of your growth in Invitational Education including the following:

- Helix: Using the 12-step Helix Chart, identify the level that you believe your school has reached at this time and briefly explain why this level best describes your school's growth.
- Growth Summary: Summarize how IAIE has influenced or changed your school since receiving the Invitational Award (or last Fidelity Award).
- Future Goals: Once you receive your Fidelity Award, what are your plans for the future with regard to Invitational Education in your school and community?

#### **Optional Portfolio:**

There is no requirement to present a portfolio for the Fidelity Award. However, if you wish to send pictures or other items to support your involvement in IE then please submit them electronically through Drop Box or on a CD, instead of in a notebook.




Figure 8.1 The Helix
