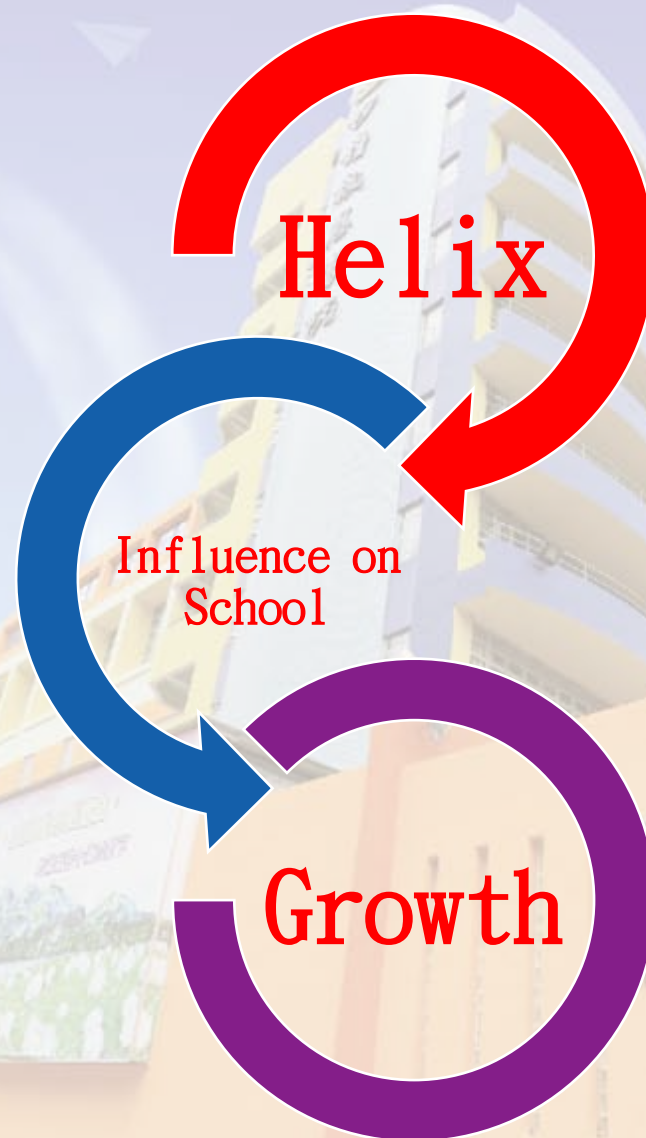

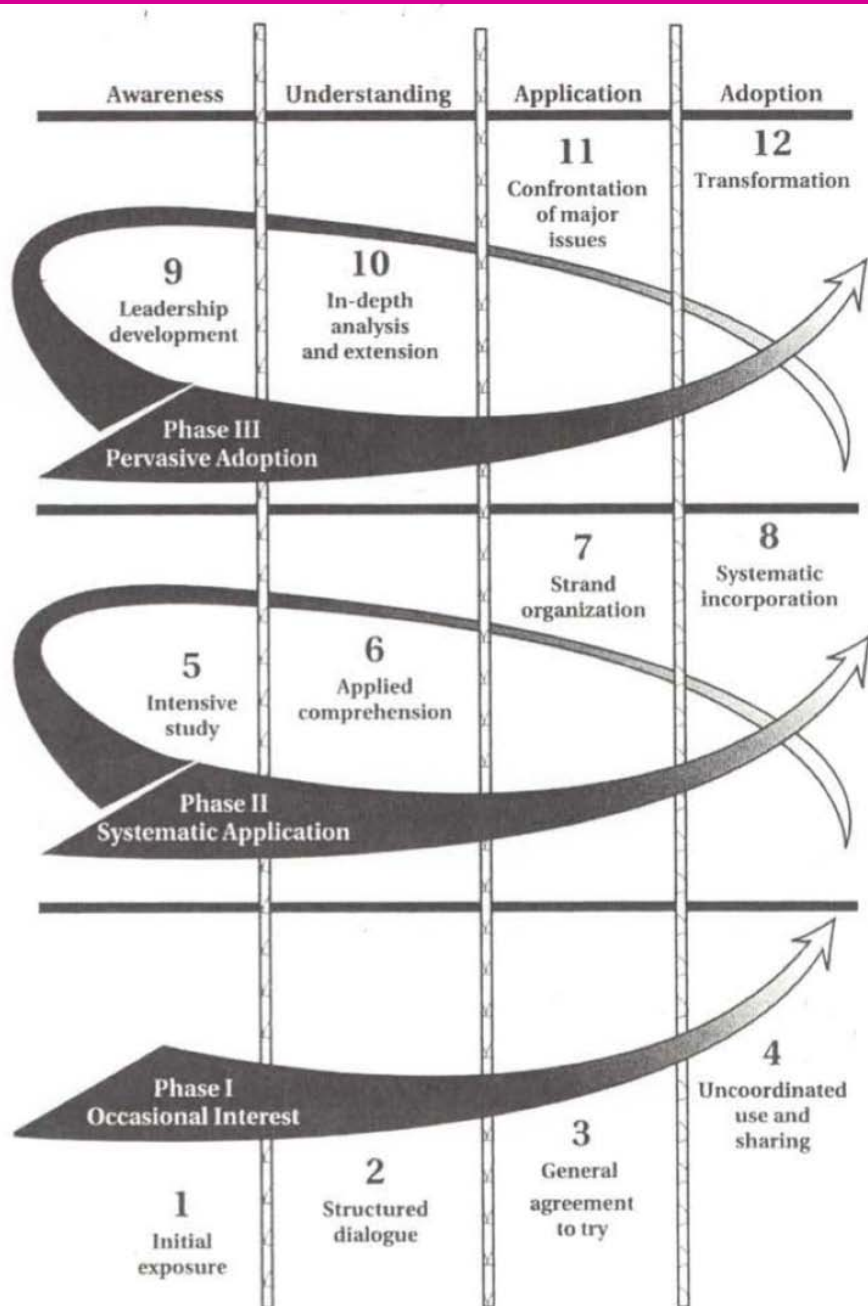

3 Parts of the Award Portfolio

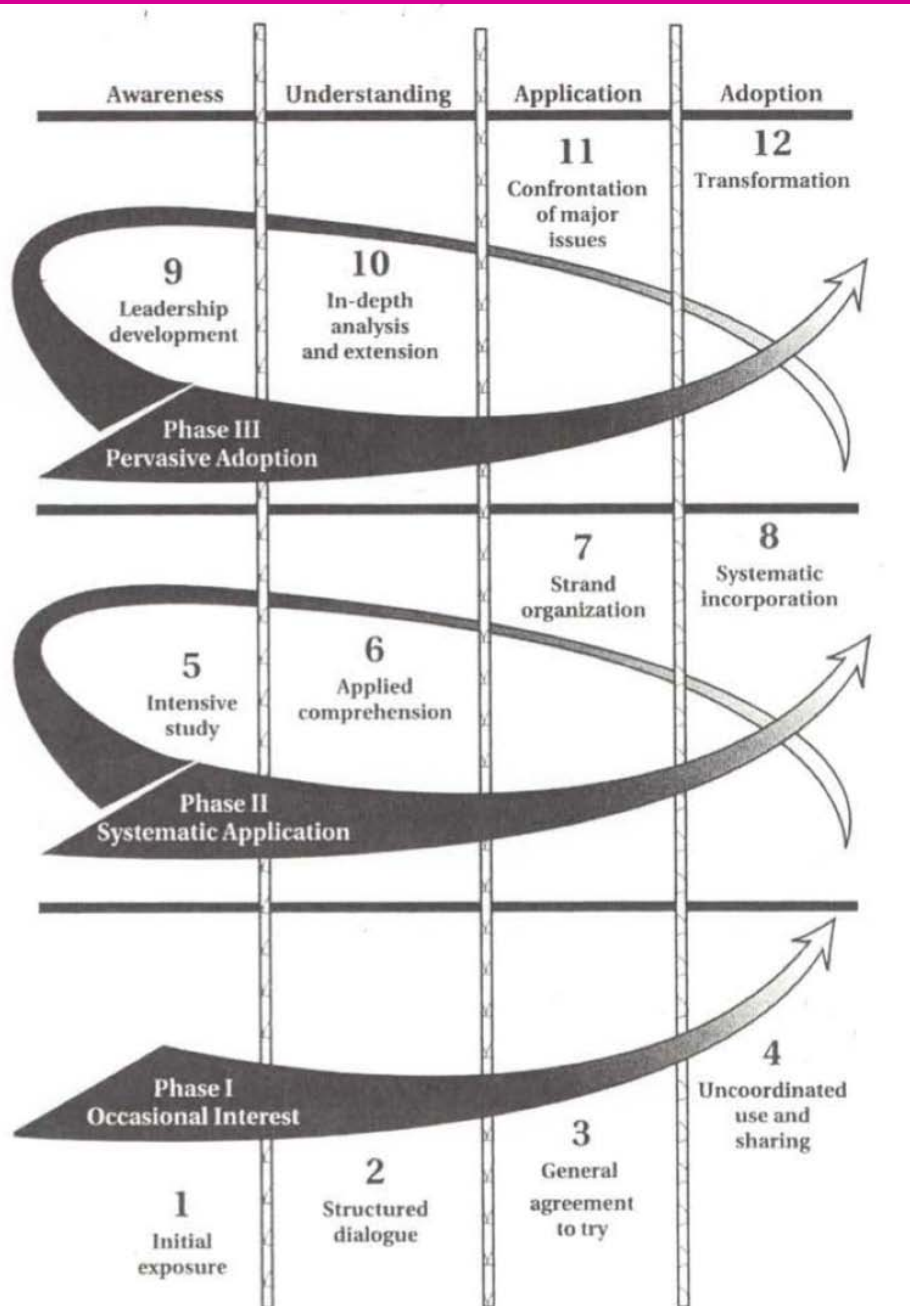


Paula Helen Stanley Fidelity Award Portfolio

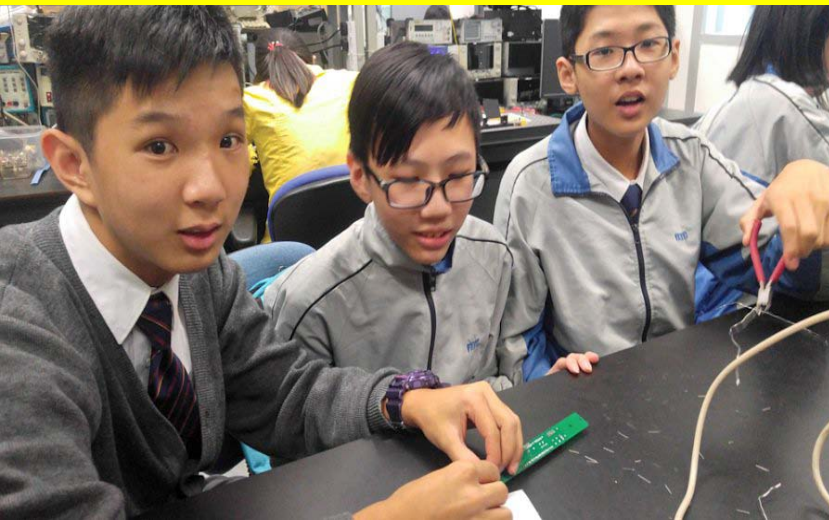

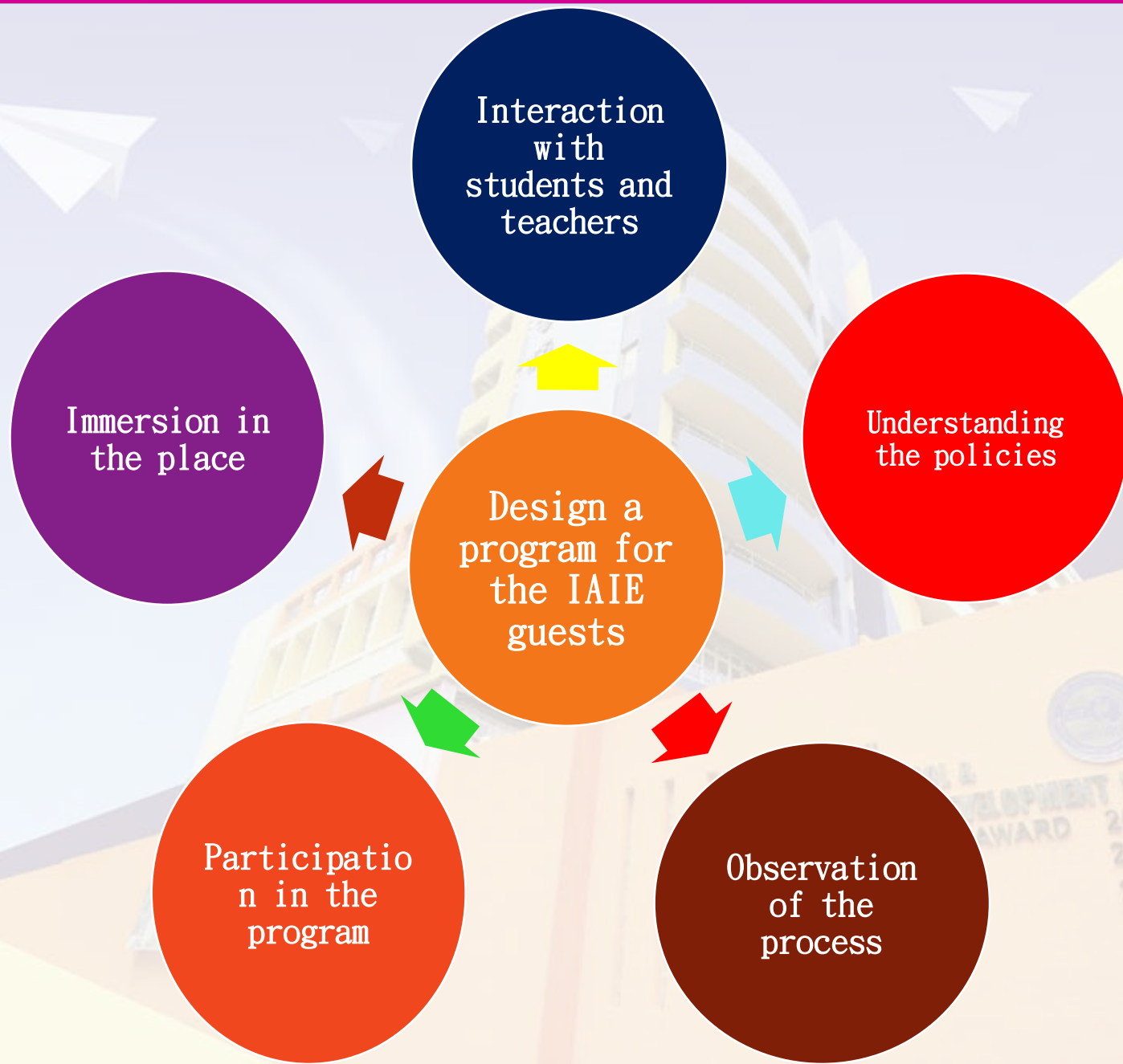
