Former SWAP Camp operations and special features

Rules (main categories throughout the camp)

- Punctuality (to class, meals, meetings) no grace periods!
- Politeness (no yelling, chasing, fighting, bullying etc)
- Dress codes- What's not expected: hot pants, tube top, sandals, (flip flops unless for shower)
- Safety issues (on site security, authorisation of absenteeism, in-case-of-any-sort-of-accidents)
- Learning attitude/ Personal Commitment (be proactive and keen on every activity)
- Languages (only English speaking from 0730-1230, Special Slave Tickets are to be issued)

Slave Club duties (toilet cleaning, washing, door keepers, services etc) (Slave Club 5-6pm daily)

- Dormitory rules as stated in the campsite
- NO Females in Males (vice versa) dormitories any time of the day!
